HOW CAN WE GROW AND BEAR FRUIT FOR HIS GLORY?

Through the New Testament, the book of Ephesians we were able to consider our corporate identity and calling as the body of Christ. Ephesians gives the church an extraordinary vision of what it means to be the body of Christ. God's purpose is that in Christ, He will be our God and we will be His people. When this is fulfilled, the body of Christ will be 'the fullness of him who fills everything in every way'. (1:23) What an incredibly high view of the church! We are God's



masterpieces, His handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. (2:10) As the gathered body of Christ, GWAC has a vision to be 'a light on the hill' and a mission to seek to be 'a caring community making, maturing and mobilising disciples of Jesus Christ, locally and globally.'

Over the next few months, we will be working together as a church community to reflect on our vision and mission as a church community and plan strategically for how we might best, as God's handiwork, use our gifts to serve. God's word points us to five strategic areas that form who we are and what we do. Will you join me in praying that God by his Spirit will lead us to discern how we might grow and bear fruit in these areas for his glory?

Serving

Will we seek to be a serving community, encouraging and equipping each other to using our gifts in God's kingdom work?
